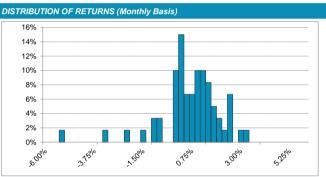

INVESTMENT MANAGERS' COMMENTARY

PERFORMANCE (Net Asset Value)

The monthly performance of the Cigogne–Convertible Arbitrage fund stands at +1.46%.

In September, financial markets continued to advance, supported by the onset of a new phase of monetary easing in the United States. The Federal Reserve lowered its target rate range to 4.00–4.25% in response to a more pronounced economic slowdown. Job creation is losing momentum, and the Bureau of Labor Statistics' annual revision subtracted nearly one million jobs from previous estimates. Jerome Powell emphasized that the easing would remain gradual, but the softness of the labor market and moderating inflation are prompting investors to anticipate further rate cuts in the coming months. Inflation, at 2.9%, remains partly driven by the reinstatement of certain tariffs, notably on pharmaceutical products. In the euro area, growth is stabilizing at a moderate pace, supported by domestic consumption and the recovery in residential investment. The ECB kept its refinancing rate at 2.15%, while leaving the door open for a final cut by year-end. Inflation, close to target, reinforces the credibility of monetary policy and supports the easing of sovereign yields. European and US Investment Grade credit indices tightened by approximately 6 and 3 basis points respectively, while the High Yield segment benefited from renewed risk appetite in an active primary market. Equity markets also advanced, buoyed by the prospect of a soft landing for the global economy.

The Convertible sub-fund recorded a solid monthly performance in an environment favorable to risk assets. The majority of positions performed well, both in the financial and corporate segments. The CoCo portfolio benefited from spread tightening in this asset class, notably on the Crédit Agricole 7.5% C30 CoCo. On the corporate side, the Figeac 1.75% 10/28 convertible bond appreciated significantly following half-year results marked by strong organic growth and a full order book. In parallel, primary market activity was strong. Participation in the ING 7% C32 CoCo enabled us to capture an attractive spread level for a quality issuer. The tender on the Forvia 2.375% 06/27 bond opened access to the new Forvia 5.375% 03/31 issue, allowing us to renew our exposure to an issuer with limited leverage and strong cash flow prospects. The primary issuance of the Exail Technologies 4% C30 perpetual convertible bond, specialized in maritime drones, was integrated to manage an implied volatility arbitrage strategy in a promising sector. Subsequently, participation in the Renault 3.875% 09/30 green issue was accompanied by the unwinding of our protection sale on this issuer at a lower level, thereby materializing a spread pick-up. Finally, a synthetic put strategy was implemented on the IAG 1.125% 05/28 convertible bond to take advantage of potential volatility in the underlying equity.

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INVESTMENT OBJECTIVES

The Convertible sub-fund is mainly built on convertible bonds arbitrage strategies. These take advantage of market anomalies that may occur between the various components of a convertible bond, namely the interest rate risk, the credit risk and the various risks related to the conversion option (equity risk, volatility, etc.).

Usually, this type of strategy consists in buying a convertible bond, hedging the equity risk by shorting the underlying, hedging the interest rate risk with a swap or with interest rate futures and, if necessary, buying the Credit Default Swap (CDS) on the creditexposed portion. The Convertible sub-fund may benefit as well from some positions on High Yield segment.

The portfolio is composed of a high number of strategies, about 200 in average, that offer a large geographical and sectoral diversification.
